

## Royal Rangers Camp at Lakeview Rental Policies

The Royal Rangers Camp at Lakeview is available for use by Royal Rangers outposts and sections, and by other church groups. Advanced reservations are required. It is possible that more than one group may be scheduled on the same weekend, depending on the size of the groups. So be as specific as possible about what facilities you need when you make your reservation.

There are rental fees required for any use of the Royal Rangers Camp facilities. These fees help offset the cost of utilities, maintenance, and property insurance for our facilities. If you desire to use the challenge course, swimming pools, water slides, or other facilities at the Lakeview Camp and Conference Center (LVCC), you need to make a separate reservation with them, and pay the appropriate fees for those facilities as well. The following are general guidelines about the use of the Royal Rangers Camp at Lakeview:

1. Reservations need to be made at least 30 days in advance. Reservations may be made by sending the attached form to the district director.
2. Accident insurance is required. Your church insurance for your group or personal insurance for **each** individual is accepted. Sections should purchase the group insurance that is available through the district Royal Rangers office.
3. For swimming and other water activities, an adult with a current life-saving card or water safety instructor's card **must** be present and in charge of those activities. If you need to hire a life guard, it may be possible to hire one by the hour from LVCC.
4. For shooting sports activities, an NRA certified range safety officer or instructor must be present and in charge of the activities. This safety officer or instructor must have physical custody of all ammunition on the premises. All shooting activities must be held in the designated shooting ranges. No firearms are to be discharged in any other part of the camp. No loaded firearms should be stored or displayed in any area of the camp other than the designated shooting ranges. All shooting activities must be arranged and approved in advance by the district Royal Rangers director so that others at the camp may receive adequate notice of shooting activities.
5. You are expected to take your trash with you when you leave the camp. Trash needs to be properly stored at night so it will not be scattered by animals.
6. All fires should be properly extinguished.
7. Any rocks that were used to create your fire ring should be placed at the base of a nearby tree to facilitate mowing of the site for future use. Any unused firewood should also be placed at the base of a nearby tree.
8. Any holes you dig should be filled in. This includes your fire pit.
9. Do not cut any live trees or shrubs unless this is part of an approved service project.
10. Leave the site cleaner than you found it. Clean up the restroom building you used and remove any trash. Be sure the doors are locked on the restroom building and the power is turned off at the circuit breaker box outside the building.
11. If you used power at the pavilion, be sure to turn off all the circuit breakers in the breaker box on the north side of the pavilion. If you hear a compressor kick in when you turn on a breaker please turn it back off – that's our walk-in cooler.

12. If you use one of the tables or trash cans from under the pavilion, be sure it is replaced when you are finished.
13. Payment is due before your event (checks payable to North Texas Royal Rangers). Sectional and district Royal Rangers events may pay after the event occurs.
14. Groups are liable for all damage done to camp facilities and will be billed for any damage or cleaning required after your event.
15. No smoking, alcoholic beverages, or illegal drugs are permitted at Lakeview Camp.
16. ATV vehicles must be approved in advance, and may only be used on improved roads. Only adults (18 and older) may drive any vehicle on the premises. Speed limit is 15 miles per hour, starting as soon as you leave the highway.
17. If your group uses any of the buildings during your stay, please return all tables and chairs to where you found them, sweep out the building, and take your trash with you. Turn all air conditioners off (in the winter heat is kept on at a very low temperature).
